UPCOMING EVENTS and INFORMATION TO KNOW

Instructions and Supplies:

- 1. August 12th through the 14th, the staff of IES will be distributing the Backpacks, Instructional Material, and School Supplies through the form of "PICK-UP" AND "BUS DELIVERY". The bus delivery will be done in the morning from 8am to 10am and then from 2pm to 4pm.**
- 2. On August 17th and through-out the 1st Semester, the IES Teachers will begin the full instructions of curriculum and collaborating with Elective Teachers (PE, ART, Music, TIWA, and Computers) to present instructions using phone conferences. This will happen for the rest of August.**
- 3. On-line learning will be going on Monday through Thursday from 8:00am to 3:00pm. Teacher will be available to communicate with them either by drive-up at IES, emails, google meet, or phone calls. On Friday, teachers will be putting grades in and communicating with families on the student progress for the week. Staff will be available 8:00am to 12:30pm**

Technology Distribution:

- 4. In September, IES will begin distributing technology to the students that are registered for the 2020-2021 SY. This will be a pick up/drive by, that will happen Monday through Friday. The dates for Distribution will be September 8th through 11th (This is tentative based on uploading the programs)**

5. IES will utilize Google Meet, Renaissance (Freckle), NWEA/MAP Assessments, Boardworks, and other resources that teachers will

Breakfast and Lunch Distribution:

6. IES will have Breakfast and Lunch that will be provided Monday through Friday. Teacher will be contact families for a number count on students that will want Breakfast and Lunch. There will be two ways that the food will be delivered and they are as follows:
 - a. **Pick-up at IES:**
 - a. This will have hot/cold meals for Breakfast and Lunch which will be 8:00am to 9am for breakfast and 11:30am to 12:30pm for lunch
 - b. **Drop-Off by School Buses:**
 - a. This will be a cold meal for Breakfast and Lunch which will be 8am to 10am for breakfast and 11:30am to 12:30pm for lunch.
7. The Breakfast and Lunch will continue to be done for days that IES is open but not all holidays, school breaks, traditional days, etc.

9. **Phone Conference**-which will be done if Google Meet or Zoom is not utilized.
10. **Emails**-which will be done if parents are working and unable to have phone meetings or virtual meetings.
11. **In-Person**-which will be done at the student drop-off where the teachers will be waiting for you to come by and have a meeting with them.
